**BECU:** Steve Hauschild introduced himself and the Boeing Employees Credit Union to the neighborhood. It now has a branch here in Spokane located on Division. They are interested in helping the neighborhood in future activities.

**Spokane Library Planning:** Andrew Chanse is looking for input from the neighborhood to see what type of library services we would like in the future. There are three categories where the Spokane Libraries are looking to get recommendations from the different parts of town. Some of the services that were favorable in the Logan were to have both quiet and collaborative spaces in the library. We also recommended the use of new technology devices and tech instruction. In the last category we recommended having large event space in the library along with a business incubation area to help local businesses.

**LNO Updates:** Nick explained to the group how the CDBG money is spent and what the options we have for the 2017 allocation. We have suggested using some money for sidewalks and have not heard back from the parks to see if there is more safety improvements we can make for Mission Park. The menu options were read at the meeting and various people supported different projects. It was recommended to have everyone review the city's overview online and will continue the discussion via emails and will be voted on in November.
